Bussing

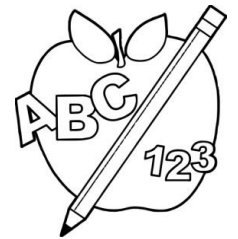
Please note, There's no PM bussing on June 1, 2, or 3 and no bussing on June 4.
